

November 4, 1976

The Crosslake City Council met in special session as a canvassing board to canvass the results of the November 2, 1976 election. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Fogelberg at 4:00 P.M. Present were Councilmen Olson, Petersen, Andolshek, Foss and Clerk Whisler.
